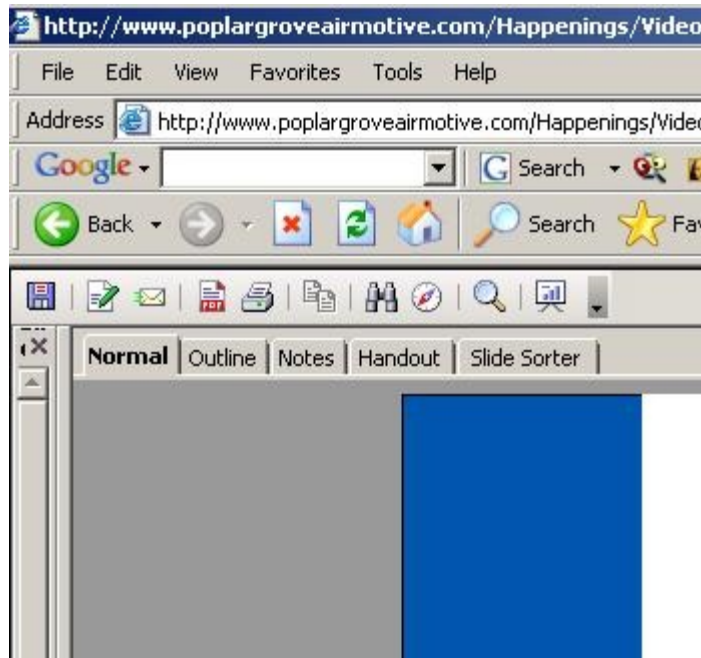
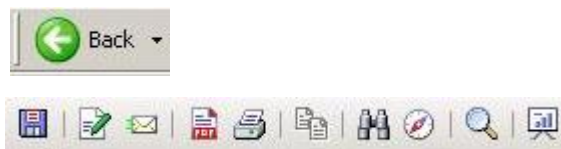


## PowerPoint help notes.

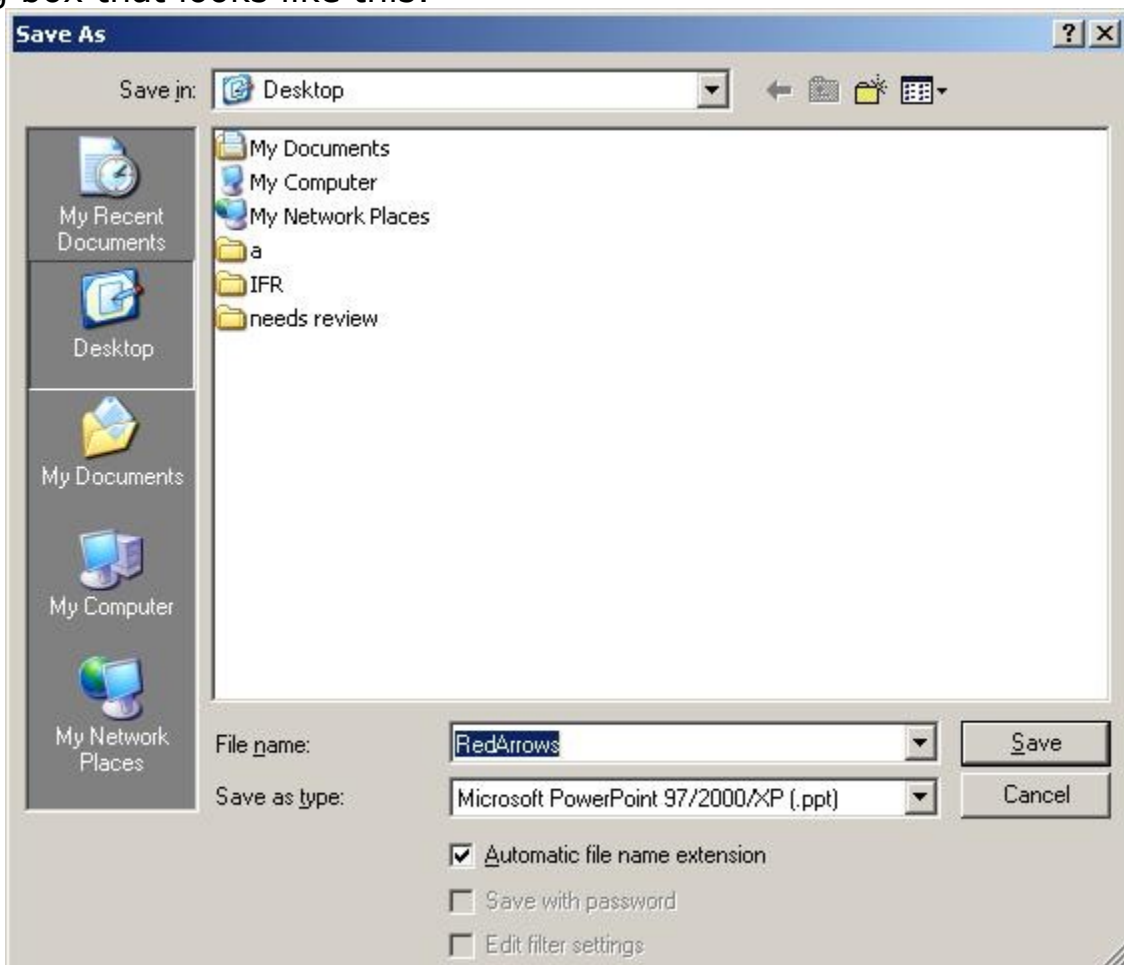
The easiest way to run this file is to save it to your desktop and then open it in PowerPoint.



Once the file has finished loading you should see something similar to this screen shot. Note this is just the upper left hand corner of the screen. Below the **Back** button and the green arrow to the left of it is another group of icons.



The icon on the left is the "**Save As**" icon. If you click that you should get a dialog box that looks like this:



Make sure you select the **Desktop** tab on the left so you can find the file later. Once saved you can just click on the file on your desktop named **RedArrows.pps**. PowerPoint will launch and if you tap **F5** the presentation will start. Clicking on the pics as they appear will advance to the next frame. Taping the **Esc** key on the keyboard will will stop the PowerPoint presentation.
